## Water testing for possible gray water contamination

As we informed in past reports, the water supply system got tested, where random condos were sampled and we are happy to share that all results came back negative for gray water contamination.

A total of 15 samples where sent for analysis (12 units - 2 per building, the 2 pools and the irrigation system).

In all the results show, that they are within the range accepted (safe) for human usage. More information is uploaded inLa Jolla Website. Water treatment plant results still on-going.

Further monitoring will be done in order to ensure that the

Water system remains safe.

## Water Treatment Plant Maintenance

As we get closer to finish the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of 2024, the water treatment plant and its cistern were due for the anual maintenance. After the Vactor truck came to desilt the plant installations, La Jolla staff completed the maintenance process by cleanning the pipelines and the greay water cistern, which took them almost 10 days to complete.

#### **Water Cistern**

The hurricaine season is upon us, an assesment was requested by the BOD to confirm the correct performance of the cistern water supply system. An external consoultant, recommended some pipelines to be replaced as well as the hydropneumatic tank.
